Idle Valley Visitor Centre is a high profile partnership and landmark environmental project for **North Nottinghamshire College & Nottinghamshire Wildlife Trust**

THE PROJECT

The project developed the Idle Valley Wide Area in Retford. A vast expanse of land and gravel pits along the river Idle north of Retford, home of the greatest concentration of wild life in North Nottinghamshire, were developed to deliver a centre of excellence for conservation and countryside education.

THE CHALLENGE

The Idle Valley Reserve includes workshops and classrooms, a training café, exhibition facilities, a network of paths for visitors (including disabled access), routes for horse riders and a visitor's centre.

Along with the building ,the scheme also required the construction of a new access road to link the site with the existing road network and associated landscaping.

The site was subject to several challenges, including site closure for bird breeding season.

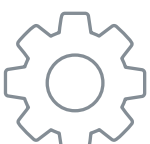
