The District Council providing a substantial proportion of the remaining 25% and is also investigating potential funding sources for the additional money needed to complete the five-year project.

THE PROJECT

The Matlock Parks Projects involved restoration and improvement of the five parks which form a linear route along the Derwent Valley (Hall Leys Park, Pic Tor, High Tor, Lovers Walks and Derwent Gardens).

THE CHALLENGE

The restoration works were varied and included specialist refurbishment of the bandstand, pavilion, clock tower, wet and dry play areas and tennis courts, together with the introduction of a new footbridge.

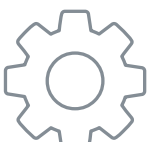
